### **Description**

The winery "Cantine Giacomo Ascheri" lies at the heart of the city of Bra in the province of Cuneo in the Italian region **Piedmont**. It was founded in 1880 and is still family owned. Today it is led by Matteo Ascheri, who is supported by the oenologist and agronomist Giuliano Baghino Edoardo Monticelli. The "Osteria Murivecchi" (restaurant) and a hotel is connected. The vineyards cover 28 hectares of vineyards around the towns of La Morra and Serralunga d'Alba in the heart of the Barolo area. There is a wide range of DOC and DOCG wines. These are **Barbera d'Alba** (Fontanelle), **Barolo** (Sorano, Sorano Coste & Bricco, Vigna dei Pola), **Dolcetto d'Alba** (Vigna Nirane, Vigna San Rocco) **Langhe**, **Nebbiolo d'Alba** (Bricco San Giacomo) and **Roero** (Arneis Christina Ascheri). The resulting wines, depending on the location of the vineyards in the three estates Montalupa (Bra), Rivalta (La Morra) and Sirano (Serralunga). The wines are aged in large oak casks (not in barrels). Every year around 300,000 bottles of wine are produced. It is also **grappa** produced.
