

**BB** | Garnet to tawny. Sweet tobacco, cedarwood, small red fruits, truffles, road tar, and rosewater nose, complex and refined. Super-balanced palate, with fine, big tannins, sweet fruit, and a long, herbal finish. Another great Nebbiolo for long-term aging. | 96

**AJ** | Clear and translucent glowing garnet red. Very fine aromas: sweet, warm fruits; wild mushrooms; cream, roses, and cologne-like spices. Rosehips, too. Fragrant, floating, and completely satisfying. Very hard not to keep tripping back to the glass after this: Romeo and Juliet. Mmm! Superb craftsmanship here, and I can't wait to sip. On the palate, it is refined, delicate, and mouth-filling. There is fine vintage concentration, but it isn't even a tiny bit overripe. All of the aromatic finesse that could be smelled in the glass is duplicated on the palate: that wealth of refined fruit, those flowers and rosehips. The tannins have been glasspapered and chamfered to perfection, and of course the vintage itself comes glowing through and drives the wine's poise and remarkable length. A ravishing wine object and a privilege to drink. Many congratulations to the family behind this wine. Wow! | 95

**MP** | Dried herbs, licorice, thyme, potpourri, tomato leaf, and baked plum single this wine out as having rather immediate charms based on a very late harvest and consequently elevated levels of alcohol. The acidity takes a back seat to the fruit and the alcohol, and this leaves the palate slightly heavy and disenchanting. | 90
