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NV Ascheri Metodo Classico Brut

This release of 2,500 bottles of bubbly draws its Nebbiolo from a single vineyard, Pisapola in Verduno. With 12 months of lees aging, the Ascheri NV Metodo Classico Brut is a lovely and refreshing sparkler with fine and persistent beading. It shows a slight gleam of copper in its luminous appearance and a lively bouquet with peach and citrus. Warm aromas of breakfast brioche with vanilla cream also make a welcome appearance. This wine has offered me a refreshing and much needed mini-break while tasting the 2017 Barolos, and it would make a nice Sunday brunch treat with some sweet and savory bakery bites.
